NATIONAL TRADITIONAL TEAM SELECTION CRITERIA

Foreword

This is the selection criteria to select the 2014 Australian National Traditional Wushu Team for the 2014 World Traditional Wushu Championships to be held on October 23 – October 29, 2014 in Anhui, China.

I. General Information

Eligibility Requirements:

Athletes must:

- a) have submitted an Application For Traditional Wushu Team and a video recording of their nominated routine;
- b) be an Australian citizen and in good health;
- c) be a member of an KWA State Member Association and be in good standing with the KWA;
- d) competing, officiating, judging or be an approved volunteer in an KWA Kung Fu Wushu State or National Championship in the year before or same year but prior to the International Event.
- e) be able to pay their own airfare, accommodation and other expense to attend the 2014 World Traditional Wushu Championships.

II. Selection Method

The Wushu Secretary-General shall review the traditional athlete's video recording and shall decide whether the traditional athlete is able to compete at a level consistent with the level of the International Event.

The KWA reserves the discretionary right to make final decisions on team composition (including changes) to comply with the International Event's team composition rules.

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR NATIONAL TEAM OFFICIALS

I. General information

- a) The final selection decision shall be made by the Wushu Secretary-General after consulting with the KWA.
- b) No one person can have more than one official position in the National Team unless there are insufficient officials.
- c) No one person can be both a Team Official and Team Athlete.
- d) Candidates who occupy any current KWA National Committee position either elected or appointed shall only be considered if there is a lack of alternative candidates.
- e) Candidates shall not occupy any current position of responsibility with the IWUF or that of any other body which hosts the International Event, which may conflict with their abilities to fully carry the duties of a National Team Official unless there are insufficient officials.
- f) There is no right of appeal against any decision made by the Wushu Secretary-General.

II. Eligibility Criteria

All candidates must:

- a) have submitted an Application For National Team Officials;
- b) be an Australian citizen or permanent resident and in good health;
- c) be a member of the KWA State Member Association and be in good standing with the KWA;
- d) have access to sufficient funding to attend the 2014 World Traditional Wushu Championships; and
- e) have a clearance by relevant government authorities as a person suitable to work with children (ie.
 Working with Children Check) if as an official there is the potential for individual contact with athletes under the age of 18 years.

III. Selection Criteria for National Head Coach and Assistant Coach

The successful candidate must:

- a) be NCAS accredited;
- have competed, officiated or judged at an KWA State or National Championship in the year before or same year but prior to the 2014 World Traditional Wushu Championships;
- c) have experience of coaching elite level athletes;
- d) have a relevant tertiary qualification (preferably a high performance coaching qualification) or an equivalent combination of training and experience;
- e) have the ability to supervise, plan, initiating, co-ordinating and conducting of suitable training programs;
- f) have an extensive working knowledge of technical wushu requirements;
- g) have an extensive working knowledge of current rules and regulations of the sport of wushu;
- h) have a high level of communication and interpersonal skills both for dealing with the athletes, coaches, team officials, competition officials and the IWUF officials; and

i) have proven capacity to relate appropriately with athletes.

IV. Selection Criteria for National Team Manager

The successful candidate must:

- a) have an understanding of the requirements of elite wushu athletes;
- b) have demonstrated a high level organisational, communication and interpersonal skills;
- c) have the ability to manage and coordinate a team of athletes;
- d) have the ability to work in partnership with the National Head Coach Coach; and
- e) have proven capacity to relate appropriately with athletes.

V. Selection Criteria for Team Medical Officer

The successful candidate must:

- a) have a medical or first aid qualification and
- b) preferably have an extensive knowledge in the field of sports medicine.
